

Ruawai-Tokatoka War Memorial Hall

Facilities

The following facilities are available in the Ruawai-Tokatoka War Memorial Hall:

1) The Main Hall

The hall is large with a wonderful floor made of native matai timber; at one time considered (and possibly still is) the best dance floor in the area.

At present it is used by Ruawai Indoor Bowls and several Netball teams for practices. It is very suitable for Badminton, Volleyball and other sports and of course dancing. There is a stage suitable for bands or performances.

The Main Hall is suitable for weddings, funerals, socials or large dining parties or for young people's groups and children's birthday parties with plenty of room to run around and play games. Even room for a bouncy castle.

The ANZAC Remembrance Service is also held here. Over 200 chairs are available for large occasions. Tables are available for sit-down dinners for over 200 people.

The Ruawai Lions have hosted their annual Christmas Senior Citizens Luncheon for over 40 years.

The Ruawai Garden Circle has two flower shows each year in the Main Hall.

2) Social Lounge/Conference Room

This spacious, carpeted room can serve a number of purposes from social gatherings to dining-in.

The room has tables and chairs and as such can be used as a dining room for smaller parties (up to 60 people).

By removing the tables and replacing them with rows of chairs it can serve as a conference or meeting room for approximately 100 people. A large projector screen is available as well as a flip chart/white board.

The room has a heat exchange unit installed which covers both cooling or heating requirements.

For large events held in the Main Auditorium, buffet style food can be served in this room.

3) Meeting Room

This room has been refurbished within the last few years and makes a lovely, comfortable room for smaller meetings (up to 25 people).

It also has tables and chairs but, if needed, the tables can be moved aside and chairs put in rows to accommodate more people. A projector screen is available.

A small kitchenette is attached to the meeting room which can be used to serve a cup of tea and a biscuit.

4) The Kitchen

The Hall boasts a large, fully equipped kitchen which can be used to prepare anything from a cup of tea to dinners for a large number of guests. The kitchen has a 'Food Premises License'.

Cutlery, Mugs and Crockery for up to 200 settings is available.

A dishwasher/steriliser was installed in 2016 and new gas hob stove with electric oven in 2017.

5) Toilets

The Ladies Toilet block has been recently renovated. Other renovations are planned as money becomes available.
